Press print screen and paste into a word document

Diagrams, tables and charts Visual=easy to understand?

Too much information= distracts from points we are making= confusing

Sets of instructions: unusual language? Said too fast?= confusing Dotted line? Dashed line?

Right hand top corner (logical but not easy to follow in real time)

Vague gestures- over there=confusing

Many ways of saying the same: decrease= drop=fall=slide=confusing
